### **Bishop Cantu Dedicates the New Catholic High School Campus in Kerrville**

Archdiocese of San Antonio Apostolic Administrator Bishop Oscar Cantú joined Our Lady of the Hills Catholic High School students, their families, teachers and administrators to dedicate their new campus at 235 Peterson Farm Road in Kerrville on Friday, September 17, 2010.

“I pray that you will find deep friendship in your years in this institution and that you will find a wonderful friend in the person of Jesus Christ,” said Bishop Cantú during the morning Mass.

Following the dedication Mass in the campus gymnasium, Bishop Cantu walked the hallways of the school blessing the rooms and those who teach in them.



Located on 86 acres in the beautiful Texas Hill Country, the new 54,000-square foot facility holds 225 students and offers eight classrooms, two science labs, two fine arts rooms, a computer lab and resource center, and a competition size gym that seats 450. The center of the school features a Chapel that is being used for liturgical gatherings.

Our Lady of the Hills opened its doors in 2002 with only 19 students and is now bustling with 114 students, who are being educated in the safe, disciplined, faith-filled and academically rigorous environment which are hallmarks of a Catholic school education.

“I thank all the students, parents, faculty, administrators, volunteers, and the Board of Directors who have put in so much work behind the scenes,” said Barry Neuburger, principal of Our Lady of the Hills.
